Subject: RFP for conducting four weeks (two weeks domestic+ two weeks Overseas Training) Training Programme under MCT Phase-II

Madam/Sir,

The National Institute of Communication Finance [NICF] is the apex level training Institute of the Ministry of Communications & IT, Government of India for the training of Accounts & Finance officers working in the Department of Telecom & Department of Posts. NICF conducts mandatory Mid Career Training (MCT) Programme for Indian Post & Telecom Accounts and Finance Service (IP&TAFS) officers, Government of India to improve their efficiency and effectiveness by imparting training for the next level of competencies of the officers at certain identified stages of their careers as per Training Policy of Govt. of India.

NICF plans to conduct Mid-Career Training (MCT) Phase-II programme for about 25 officers who have completed 9-16 years of service. During this phase of MCT Programme, the officers will also be given training inputs in the form of an Overseas exposure Module, to the current scenario prevailing in the other countries in the Postal & Telecommunications sector as well as other important area, highlighting the important achievements in meeting challenges in these countries.

2. The proposed training programme would include the following two components-

- i) Domestic Training Component for two weeks (excluding journey time) to be conducted in India in IIM or reputed Management Institute recognised by DOPT.
- ii) Overseas Training Component for two weeks (excluding journey time) for the officers so that they can obtain the following training inputs:-
 - (a) Public policy, Regulation & Planning processes in various countries with special reference to Postal, Telecommunications & IT Sector.
 - (b) Current and future technologies for Telecom and Posts.
 - (c) Government policies and regulations in ICT sectors.
 - (d) Prevailing market forces in Fixed Phone, Mobiles and Broad band.
 - (e) Licensing and Taxation system with reference to Telecom and Posts.

- (f) Broadband Infrastructure.
- (g) Govt. funding in research & development
- (h) Public – private partnership in roll out of broadband services.
- (i) Disbursement schemes of Universal Service Obligation Fund etc. in the international scenario.
- (j) Role of Postal sector in banking & insurance in the country.
- (k) Convergences in ICT and its efficient and effective usage for improving governance and service delivery.

3. We would like your help in conducting this training preferably on turn key basis in the month of September/October, 2012.


4. We, thus, request you to send us a reply to our proposal. Please also provide us details about the academic inputs, field visits to various parts of the country (we would like you to suggest the same) and an exposure tour to other neighbouring countries as well as all the logistics arrangements for training and field exposure in the neighbouring country. The following information may also be provided as indicated below:

- Class room inputs (25 to 30% only- should be kept to the minimum) provided in the interactive mode.
- Field visits to Companies/ Organisations/Institution
- Exposure to various schemes / projects/ programmes
- Coordination and training arrangement for similar exposure in neighbouring countries(Preferably minimum three to four developed countries)
- Accommodation (single occupancy for participating officers and for faculty coordinators)
- Internal travel arrangements in the country.
- Comprehensive insurance for entire period of overseas training.
- Visa & other travel requirements excluding air travel from India to the first destination country and back to India from the last destination country. However inter country cost of travel (road, train & air) should be included in the proposal.
- Experience in organizing such overseas training for any Ministry / Deptt. of Govt. of India.
