Introduction & Objectives:

This two-day program is being offered in partnership amongst NICF, ITU and IISc Bangalore to train the participants from government, industry and academia on various facets of the ITU standardization process and standard essential patents in the ICT sector.

Day 1 of the workshop will start with panel discussion on the role played by all stakeholders, including government, academia, industry and start-ups in enhancing the ITU standardization process. This will be followed by session with focus on ITU's activities in the field of ICT standardization, guide participants on how to write effective contributions, make presentations along with negotiations and feedback. There will be demonstrations followed by role play exercises to develop leadership in this area.

Day 2 of the workshop will focus on two aspects – 1) understanding the importance of IPR and SEPs in technical education and technological innovation, along with panel discussions on the various dimensions of the SEPs in ICT and 2) the upcoming World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly 2024.
