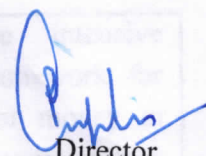

These examinations involve a detailed technical and financial scrutiny of contracts, with the aim of identifying irregularities, procedural lapses, and potential acts of corruption. As part of Vigilance Awareness Week, this webinar seeks to familiarize participants with the methodology, scope, and significance of conducting CTE-type intensive examinations. The

The session will also highlight how these examinations contribute to preventive vigilance by identifying system weaknesses and recommending corrective actions. By equipping vigilance officers, technical staff, and procurement professionals with practical insights and best practices, this webinar will strengthen their ability to conduct effective inspections and uphold the principles of integrity and good governance.
